Before the reading the book grab Activity 1 and ask your child these questions:

1. Which animals do you think can swim?
2. Which animal is blue?
3. Which animal starts with a letter C?
4. Which animals live in a house?
5. Which animal have you seen before?
6. Which animal can hop?

The child needs to circle the answer on the laminated sheet with the whiteboard marker.

Activity 2

During the reading:

While you read have them follow along with their mini booklet. Ask them to highlight sight words. Go over the book with them after.

Ask them these questions between pages:

1. What other kind of bears can you name?
2. How are the duck and bird different?
3. Have you ever seen a purple cat?
4. What sound does a frog make?
5. Where do sheep live?

Activity 3

After the reading:

Read all the laminated cards together. As you go over them with your child spell them a loud together. Mix the cards up and play charades.

After Charades ask:

- Did you like the story? Why or why not?
- What other animals do you want in the story?
- Tell me about the teacher in the story? What is she like?
