Stop One: Sightseeing Website of map

Step 1- go to: <http://www.whats4eats.com/central-america/nicaragua-cuisine>


1. Scroll down and read the names and look at all the pictures of the food.





Stop One: Sightseeing Website of map

1. How does the Granada house look different than the one you and your family live in?




2. Have you and your family ever been to the beach? What was it like? If not what do you think it would be like?
