What We Did With Our Week:

This week in math, we worked on understanding foundational skills for math fact games and fluency. In science, we learned about earthquakes. We investigated how they form, their characteristics, and how they affect the Earth. In social studies, we used the earthquake unit as a multimodal lesson. We learned about how earthquakes cause an impact on people and their homes. We also discussed relief ideas and laws that could be created to help. In English, the students started a new unit titled, "Make believe." This will help them to use their imagination as well as deep thinking/feeling elements. We also reflected on how they can use peer suggestions to better their pieces. We have also continued to partner share their writing pieces and after the partner share, we do a short discussion about the feedback they received.
