- Have your child tell you stories during bath time, before bed and any other windows during your day.
- Have the family read a book together everyday for at least 20 minutes.
- Allow your child to be the waitress for dinner. Let them ask what you would like and write down your orders. Let them explain to you what the specials are and what is in each special.




Teaching environments

- Give the children plays to put on for the class with scripts. Make sure to provide props!
- Consistently ask thought provoking questions that require in depth answers and encourage group discussions.
- Have Independent reading.
- Read a loud to the children each day. Discuss the book before and after the reading.
- Allow the students to have time to journal write.
- Encourage discussion about personal experiences.
- Help the students see they all have connections with each other.

How to Encourage and Give Motivation:

1. Remind them they are not alone. This is a group effort! This will be evident when you do language activates with them instead of just watching them do it.
2. Reassure them that they are smart and give specific positive feedback to the child.
3. Take full advantage of any opportunity that you can make into a teaching moment.
4. Constantly lead the child to stimulating discussion and guide them to self- discoveries.
